Association (PATA), is currently conducting the PATA Tourism Destination Resilience (TDR) Project as an outcome of the High-Level Meeting between PATA and PDOT held last 01 April 2021. The said project aims to assist the Destination Management Organizations (DMOs) to build resilience, withstand adversities, and ensure sustainable tourism development.

The PATA is a not-for-profit membership association that acts as a catalyst for the responsible development of travel and tourism to, from and within the Asia Pacific region. Since 1951, PATA has led from the forefront as the leading voice and authority on travel and tourism in the Asia Pacific region.

Relative to the program, PATA's project team of industry experts have developed a blueprint for TDR and a library of tools and resources to build capacity which includes the Tourism Destination Training. The said training consists of sub-national consultative workshops to

assist DMOs in preparing the TDR process (risk assessment, risk management, and adaptive capacity plans). A facilitated TDR assessment conducted by PATA experts will provide detailed feedback for target priority areas of the customized TDR workshops. Moreover, the PDOT and PATA will conduct the Tourism Destination Resilience Training on 30-31 March 2022 in the province of Siguijor. In this regard, the PDOT-OTDPRIM is in need of a DOT-Accredited Travel and Tour Operator to provide requirements on accommodation, meals, land and sea transfers and RT-PCR. **II: SCOPE AND SERVICES** A.
