Terms of Reference

I. Project Title: Introduction to Cloud Computing and Virtualization

II. Date/Venue: October 10-12, 2022 (3 half-days)/ online session

III. Background/Rationale

Cloud computing creates new paradigms of information architecture and core business models of organizations across different industries. Today's organization must be able to quickly adapt to the market needs and hence most of them started to replace physical computers (servers and desktops) with "virtual machine". This 12-hour course curriculum is designed for beginners and this training will enable the participants to understand various concepts around cloud computing and how to apply them in an organization's Information Technology (IT) landscape.

Course objectives:

At the end of the program, the participants are expected to:

- understand the common terms and definitions of virtualization and cloud computing;
- understand the technical capabilities and business benefits of virtualization and cloud computing and how to measure these benefits;

- describe the landscape of different types of virtualization and understand the different types of clouds;
- compare and contrast various cloud storage and databases;
- comprehend the concepts of global infrastructure and cloud security and demonstrate how cloud computing is applied in modern IT and government systems
