III. RATIONALE AND OBJECTIVES

In line with the mandate of the PCSSD to formulate rules, regulations, safety standards, and operating procedures for the development of the country as a premier diving area in Asia, it is necessary that the PCSSD employees be competent with the dive industry, equipped with knowledge and skills, and be reputable and credible to represent the Commission to the dive stakeholders.

Scuba diving involves the use of self-contained underwater breathing apparatus (SCUBA) and is considered a dangerous activity if not done correctly. It entails some risks, such as decompression sickness, arterial air embolism, barotrauma, and lung overexpansion. Scuba diving, on the other hand, can be done safely provided a person is well-equipped, knowledgeable and properly trained.

Currently, the PCSSD employees are still in the process of upgrading their skills and knowledge in scuba diving. Acquiring further training will significantly improve their capabilities in performing their tasks and contributing to the implementation of the agency's mandates

With this, the PCSSD employees will be conducting dive training on 15 to 24 October 2022. This includes classroom discussion, pool sessions, and open water dives.

- License the PCSSD employees from their current certification level to the next;
- Increase the level of competency of PCSSD employees; and
- Prepare the PCSSD employees in representing the Commission to the dive stakeholders and dive events.
