INVITATION TO BID (IB)

The Philippine Department of Tourism (PDOT), through the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), invites suppliers/contractors to bid for the hereunder project. Considering that the Philippine booth is to be set-up at the venue of the event in Dubai, UAE, bidders with company based or has an affiliate in UAE, will be preferred.

Name of Project: **Booth Design, Set-up and Dismantling of the Philippine Booth at the Aviation Show MENASA 2018**

Brief description of the Project: Services of a company engaged in the business of designing and set-up of booths for travel and consumer fairs for the Philippine Stand at the Aviation Show MENASA 2018

Approved Budget for the Contract: One Million Forty-Seven Thousand Four Hundred Philippine Pesos (PhP1,047,400.00) or its equivalent in US Dollar

Contract Duration: November 12-15, 2018

Prospective bidders should have experience in undertaking a similar project within the last two (2) years with an amount of at least 50% of the proposed project for bidding. The Eligibility Check/Screening as well as the Preliminary Examination of Bids shall use non-discretionary "pass/fail" criteria. Post-qualification of the lowest calculated bid shall be conducted.


