Description

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

I. BIDDER : Ground Handler / Tour Operator

II. PROJECT TITLE : Familiarization Tours for the South Korean Market

III. BACKGROUND :

The project aims to revive the Korean dive market to the Philippines, which has shrunk to around 18% during the COVID-19 pandemic, as shown in the table above by the number of C-card issuances. Two main factors, threats, and weaknesses, have been identified as slowing down the recovery of the Korean dive market as discussed above:
Diving shops/centers: In 2019, there were approximately 200 dive shops/centers in the Philippines owned by Koreans, but due to the COVID-19 pandemic, less than 100 are currently operational across all diving shops/centers.
Raising awareness of Philippine diving: It is crucial for the DOT to send a clear message to the Korean diving community and consumers that the Philippines is open for business and welcoming Korean divers.

• To address these issues, it is necessary to either provide information and contacts on how to establish dive-related businesses in the Philippines, such as dive resorts, dive centers, restaurants, spas, and so on in the long term or to utilize existing dive shops/centers in the Philippines owned by Filipinos/other nationals for Korean divers in the short

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term. Although the number of dive shops/centers in the Philippines owned by Koreans is expected to recover in years, taking this as an opportunity, the existing dive shops/centers in the Philippines owned by Filipinos/other nationals can expand their Korean market this time.

• Therefore, familiarization tours for diving centers/clubs in Korea and promotional activities such as a Philippine dive festival both in the Philippines and Korea are highly needed, together with a partnership with PADI, the largest and most prominent organization in the scuba diving industry worldwide. Product presentations for Philippine dive destinations featuring Anilao, Puerto Galera, Coron, Moalboal, Bohol, Southern Leyte, Malapascua, and Dumaguete, and B2B networking meetings for Philippine sellers and Korean buyers will be conducted. Other activities such as familiarization tours and a solo Philippine dive event dubbed "Philippine Dive Festival in Seoul" can generate new business outputs in the short term.
