Specific Requirements • Dive team shall be composed of 6 members with the following background: \Box At least 3 to 4 members are technically trained and have an experience in technical diving: Members should be Open Water Dive Instructors or Specialty Instructors specifically in Technical Diving and above; □ At least 1 member should have relevant experience in Underwater photography and videography; □ At least 1 or 2 members are Marine Biologist and have relevant field experience; □ At least 1 or 2 members have relevant experience in Geophysical, and Mapping survey; □ At least 3 to 4 members have 10 years of experience in SCUBA diving. Final output should be available 45 working days after the exploratory dive assessment and must include the following: □ Provision of full videography and photography of selected dive sites; □ Provision of sketched diagram with basic corresponding depths and point of interest, with GPS references; □ Provision of marine ecology assessment and fish population specifics; Provision of visibility, current, and tidal observation at the time of the assessment; Provision of virtual representation of potential dive sites; \Box Videos, photos, sketches, soft copy of report, and other files should be placed in a 1TB external hard drive; □ Final report should be book bound in 10 copies. □ Final report and output should be delivered to Department of Tourism Regional Office IV-B (MIMAROPA) with address, 2/F 351 Sen. Publication and printing of ten (10) copies of the Exploratory Dive Assessment (printed and digital copy) 5 working days after the presentation/finalization of draft **III. LOGISTICS:** A. Service Provider 1. Shall provide own scuba gears and tanks 2. Shall provide camera equipment needed for the activity 3. Shall provide budget for off-board gasoline during the 4-day assessment B. DOT Regional Office IV-B (MIMAROPA) 1. Shall provide land, air, and water transportation for the whole duration 2. Shall provide food and accommodation for the whole duration of the stay 3. Shall shoulder roundtrip airfare with 40kg baggage allowance per person. An excess of baggage made on the actual flight shall be borne by the service provider. IV. APPROVED BUDGET FOR THE CONTRACT The Approved Budget for the Contract is FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY-NINE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED EIGHTEEN PESOS ONLY (P589,718.00) inclusive of all government taxes and charges. The winning bid, however, shall be determined based on the proposal with the most advantageous financial package cost, provided that the amount of the bid does not exceed the above total budget. V. PAYMENT SCHEMES Terms of payment to the winning bidder shall be in accordance with the government procedure (send bill arrangement). Failure to comply with the terms and conditions of the contract will result in the payment of corresponding penalties and liquidated damages in the amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the contract price by the winning bidder.
