II. PROJECT RATIONALE AND OBJECTIVES

The Department of Tourism (DOT) - MIMAROPA Region as part of its Gender and Development (GAD) activity will support the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW) project ORANGE YOUR ICON, an 18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women (VAW), aligning the Philippine Campaign with UNITE by 2030 and sustaining the traction gained from the 2016 to 2021 theme, "VAW-free Community Starts with Me," which will be held on November 25, 2023 in Boac, Marinduque. The upcoming Campaign will focus on the new recurring banner "UNITEd for a VAW-free Philippines" which aims to highlight the powerful impact of combining individual efforts towards a collaborative and united thrust towards a VAW-free Philippines.
