	IV. HANDLING AND DELIVERY
	 The Service Provider must ensure that vaccines are transported and stored according to the manufacturer's recommended temperature range of +2°C to +8°C until the point of administration (Cold Chain Policy). For employees who are on travel/leave on the scheduled dates, vaccines shall be reserved and delivered prior the

completion of the project. The DOT Medical Clinic will be responsible for administering the vaccines to the concerned employees.

II. Clarification of Bidders

Queries	Clarification
If by lots, how many sets of documents need to be submitted?	1. Two separate sets of bidding documents. Section 19.2 of Section II Instruction to Bidders of the Bidding Docs states that: If the Project allows partial bids, bidders may submit a proposal on any of the lots or items, and evaluation will be undertaken on a per lot or item basis, as the case maybe. In this case, the Bid Security as required by ITB Clause 15 shall be submitted for each lot or item separately.
2. Do we need to attach supporting documents for the Statement of all its Ongoing Government and Private Contracts (Annex "A")?	2. There is no need to submit attachments for the Statement of all its Ongoing Government and Private Contracts (Annex A), however during Post-qualification, DOT reserves the right to validate, verify, and ascertain all statements made in the said Statement. On the other hand, prospective bidders are required to attach the supporting documents required for the Single Largest and Completed Contracts (SLCC) (refer to Annex B of the Bidding Documents).

The unamended portion of the bidding documents shall remain the same.

This shall form an integral part of the Bidding Documents.
