#### II. On Clarifications of Bidders:

1. Do we need to attach supporting documents for the Statement of all its Ongoing Government and Private Contracts (Annex "A")?	1. There is no need to submit attachments for the Statement of all its Ongoing Government and Private Contracts (Annex A), however during Post-qualification, DOT reserves the right to validate, verify, and ascertain all statements made in the said Statement.  On the other hand, prospective bidders are required to attach the supporting documents required for the Single Largest and Completed Contracts (SLCC) (refer to Annex B of the Bidding Documents).
In Financial proposal, do we have to follow the recent PADPAO rates released February 01, 2024 including all government fees?	2. We will follow the 2023 PADPAO rates except for the Administrative Fee. In the PADPAO, the imposed Administrative Fee is 24% however we are just following the 20% Administrative Fee in compliance with prevailing Labor laws and regulations. Regarding the government fees we follow the recent adjustment issued by the PhilHealth and PAG-IBIG.

3. How many copies required for the submission of the bidding documents?	3. Submission of one (1) original and five (5) duplicate copies of the bidding documents
4. Do we have to follow the 396 working days per PADPAO or still remain at 395 working days?	4. We will follow the 395 working days as stated in the 2023 PADPAO because the contract will be on May to December 2024 and will not be affected by the Leap Year.
5. On Section III. Bid Data Sheet, ITB Clause 20 Item No. 3 How many security personnel should be submitted?	5. For purposes of Post-qualification of the Lowest/Single Calculated Bidder (L/SCB) must be able to present the individual training certificates of each security personnel that will be deployed in the DOT.

7. The standard if we segregate the day shift and night shift, if night shift it will automatically have 13% not divided by 2. Based on Law, 10:00 pm-6:00 am is multiplied by 10%. And if it is combination of day shift and night sift, it wll be divided by 2.	7. The computation for the Night Shift duty shall be multiplied by 10% and divided by 2.
8. Clarification with regards to SSS deduction.	8. Basic pay less 13 <sup>th</sup> month pay.

#### III. Others:

1. In case of tie or when two (2) or more bidders are determined and declared as Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB), the DOT BAC shall follow the Guidelines on the use of Non-discretionary/Non-discriminatory Selection criteria as Tie-breaking Method issued by the GPPB thru Circular No. 06-2005.
