Procurement of Tokens and Giveaways for Tourism Champions Challenge (TCC) Awarding Ceremony in PICC 12 April 2024

Office of Special Concerns, DOT Building, Makati City

The Tourism Champions Challenge (TCC) is an annual process of invitation, enhancement, selection, and execution

for tourism-related projects targeted to enhance destination areas of local government units (LGUs) through sustainable, inclusive, and resilient tourism strategies. It aims to enhance and develop local tourism destinations by soliciting project ideas and providing technical assistance through the conduct of capacity building to augment the LGU's competence in developing and managing projects, as well as support excellent tourism projects. A total of 98 project proposals from 90 LGUs were received by the DOT Regional Offices (ROS). Among these, 41 proposals were endorsed by the DOT ROS to the TCC Committee on 30 June 2023. Subsequently, 15 LGU proposals were selected through a comprehensive evaluation process conducted by the TCC Committee. Knowledge Partner, PricewaterhouseCoopers (PWC) Philippines, conducted thorough review/ validation on the selection processes utilized by the DOT ROS and TCC Committee. A face-to-face training activity was conducted at Puerto Princesa City on 20 to 24 November 2023 with the 15 selected LGUs to enhance their project proposals. The LGUs have presented their final presentation to the TCC Committee and invited judges on 18 January 2024 in Cebu City. This will be followed by the TCC Awarding Ceremony on 15 April 2024 in Metro Manila. In line with this, the DOT Office of Special Concerns is in need on an enterprise to provide, arrange, package, and deliver the following tokens or giveaways for 200 guests and participants during the TCC Awarding Ceremony. V. Objectives As part of the succeeding Phase of the TCC implementation, the TCC Committee shall conduct the TCC Awarding Ceremony after the final presentation of LGU project proposals.
