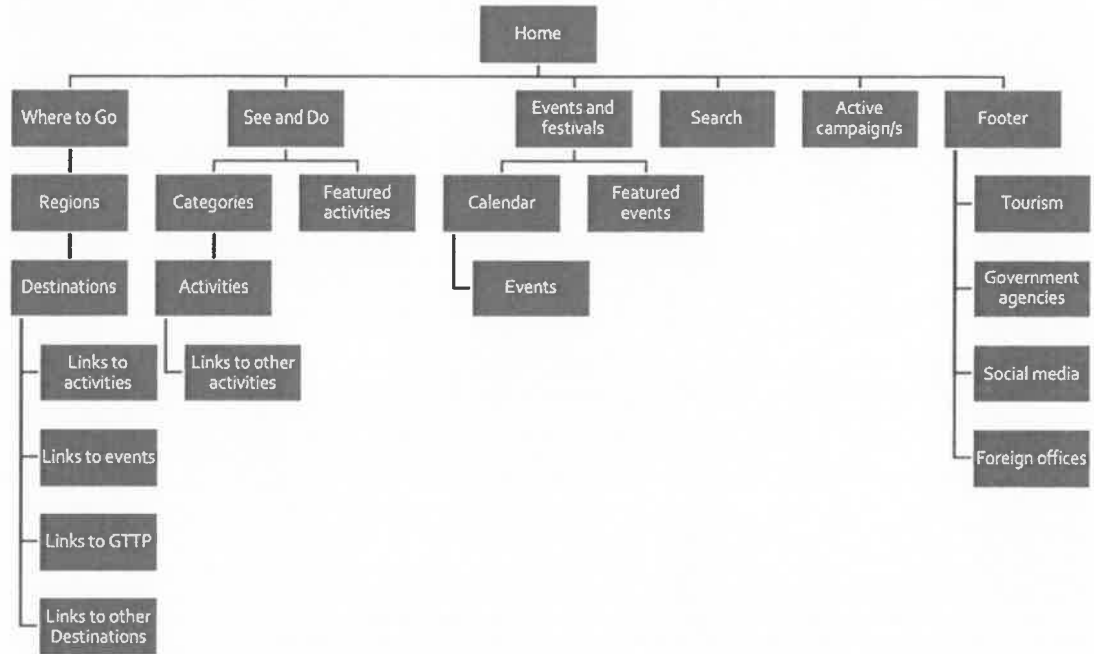

3. Is the agency allowed to make changes on the previously submitted proposed team/set of CVs from the Eligibility Stage?

Section 33.3 of the implementing Rules and Regulation (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184 (RA9184) states that "There should be no replacement of key personnel before the awarding of contract, except for justifiable reason as may be determined by the BAC, such as, illness, death or resignation provided it is duly supported by relevant certificates, or any delay caused by the Procuring entity. The BAC shall immediately consider negotiation with the next ranked consultant if unjustifiable replacement of personnel by the first ranked firm is made. Once the contract has been awarded, no replacement shall be allowed by the HoPE until after fifty (50%) of the personnel's man-months have been served, except for justifiable reasons, subject to appropriate sanctions as prescribed in the PBDs."

4. Will electronic signature of personnel be allowed for this stage of submission of their CVs?

Bidders will be allowed to submit unnotarized TPF.6 (Format of Curriculum Vitae for proposed Professional Staff), as well as the use of digital or electronic signature on the said form, pursuant to GPPB Resolution Nos. 16-2019 and 09-2020. However, shortlisted bidder is required to submit the CVs of personnel with original signature and notarized during post-qualification.
