PROJECT: DÉVELOPMENT OF TRAINING MODULE FOR MARINE WILDLIFE TOURISM

INTERACTIONS

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The passing of the DOT-DA-DILG-DENR JMC No. 01 s. 2020 - Rules and Regulations governing the conduct of Marine Wildlife Tourism Interactions in the Philippines last year encourages compliance to the provisions of this new Administrative Order which ensures that national standards are implemented in the conduct of tourism activities involving marine wildlife. The provisions are aligned with other national laws, especially that most of the species involved are threatened and protected in the country.

There are a number of sites in the country that have been involved in marine wildlife tourism interactions since the mid-1990s, some sites are still developing or in its early years of operations, some are emerging destinations and others have the potential to be developed into a marine wildlife interaction site either as a main or side attraction in a destination. The provisions in the JMC will support these sites by professionalizing their operations, not only for the benefit of the species involved but to the safety of the tourists and the enhancement of their interaction experience as well.

The training program to be developed under this project will be used to equip destination stakeholders in the proper operations of marine wildlife tourism interactions in compliance to the JMC.

SCOPE OF WORK

This consultancy will contribute to the delivery of a training program on marine wildlife tourism interactions related to the implementation of the DOT-DA-DILG-DENR JMC No. 01 s. 2020 - Rules and Regulations governing the conduct of Marine Wildlife Tourism Interactions in the Philippine.

Specific activities will include:
